Discussion, Ms. Henkel spoke on behalf of the resolution, the petitioner is requesting a map amendment to change the zoning from an AG 1 to an I-1 and in addition is requesting a special use for the purpose of operating his business. The parcel is adjacent to the City of Dixon and the City has filed an objection against this request. Therefore, the county board vote has to be three quarters of the majority in favor of the resolution for it to pass. State's Attorney Charley Boonstra spoke about Statue 55 ILCS 5/5-12014 subsection B which says that if there were an objection to the map amendment it would need to be by a vote of three quarters of the majority of the County Board to approve it. The ZBA voted unanimously to pass this resolution. Mr. Kitson spoke on his approval of the petition and the positive impact it will have for the county.

A. Board of Health: Katie White, Liaison

Ms. White stated they had no meeting this month. Updates:

- FDA has authorized a second bivalent booster - for 65 and above or moderately or severely immunocompromised.
- Partnership for a Healthy Lee County (PHLC) group is various community organizations that work together to address health issues
- School sports physicals and looking at expanding the blood lab draws
- New pamphlet is out for the Lee County Health Department for programs and services
- At the May meeting the Health Department will be presenting changes to environmental health fees for the Board's consideration. Ms. White has sent out an email with some high level information regarding the changes.

B. 911 Board: Keane Hudson, Liaison

Mr. Hudson stated minutes are in OnBoard. Highlights:

- In 2022 the average daily call volume for the Sheriff's Office was 56, Dixon police department was 52 and 26 for 911 calls in a 24-hour period.
- During the March 31st storm the call volume increased dramatically. From 6-8 p.m. the Sheriff's Office received 56 calls, and the Dixon police department received 31 calls. During the April 4th storm in a one-hour period from 12 to 1

p.m. the Sheriff's Office received 34 calls, Dixon police department 35 calls and 27 calls in a one-hour time frame for 911 calls.

- Director Dallas spoke on behalf of the volume of calls they received on these two days and the outstanding job everyone did responding to these calls and all the county departments responses.

Mr. Kitson stated that they met in Springfield on March 28-29. Highlights:

B. Lee County Electrical Aggregation Award

County Administrator Ryerson spoke on behalf of this award. Highlights:

- In 2011 State of Illinois passed Legislation that allowed government entities to consolidate small businesses and residences into an aggregation program.
- Referendum was passed by Lee County which allows County to approve an electrical aggregation supplier and specified term for aggregation program.
- Periodically the County solicits bids and selects a provider
- Mike Mudge is Lee County's consultant that assists us with the bidding and selection process.
- Mr. Mudge received 3 bids from providers
- County Board needs to approve the provider and the term of the contract for the next period.

Motion by Mr. Kitson to go forward with MC Squared Energy Services for a 2-year contract at 7.45. **Second** by Mr. Schielein. Under discussion Mr. Mudge stated that last summer ComEd's rate was 12 cents kilowatt hour and the rate we tied into 3 years ago was 5.6 cents. This is a huge savings for the county. Opt-out notification letters will go out in June. **Motion carried** unanimously by voice vote.

C. Approval of the Lee County FY2022 Financial Audit

Treasurer Paul Rudolphi stated the FY2022 Financial Audit is completed and it is a clean and unmodified audit. ARPA funds have about 4 million remaining, IMRF pensions are over 100% funded. **Motion to approve** the FY2022 Financial Audit. **Moved** by Mr. Schielein. **Second** by Robertson. **Motion carried** unanimously by voice vote.

D. SIPC Intergovernmental Agreement (Cooperative)

County Administrator Ryerson stated that the Illinois Governmental joint purchasing act allows local governments to purchase supplies and services jointly. Lee County is looking to join the Co-op and is in need of the ability to sign an intergovernmental agreement upon approval from the State's Attorney. **Motion is to approve** the SIPC Intergovernmental Agreement pending review/approval of State's Attorney Boonstra. **Moved** by Mr. Wilson. **Second** by Ms. Naylor. **Motion carried** unanimously by voice vote.

County Administrator Ryerson added that about 1 year ago the county board did ask for some form of documentation and a form was created. We were fairly successful in receiving these forms back up until recently. In particular there is resistance to completing the form when individuals have served on the same board for a long time. In the future we will continue to request the form, and it will be up to the County Board members whether to approve the appointment if no form is returned. Refusing to approve an appointment could leave a Board without enough members for a legal meeting, impacting the entity's ability to operate. **Motion carried** by voice vote with Mr. Kitson abstaining.

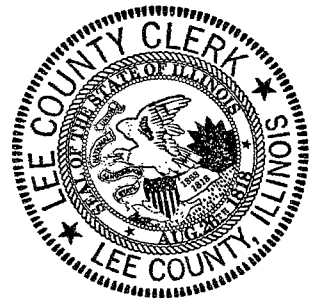

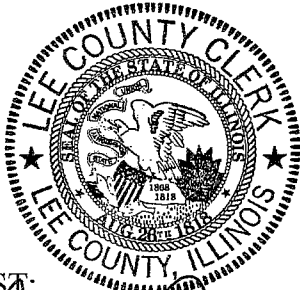

1. The Special Use Permit be limited to not more than 6 acres, to be defined via survey, with a legal description.
2. When Petitioner Judi Harvin is no longer conducting her yoga retreat business, the Special Use Permit shall cease to exist.
3. If the property is ever sold or transferred, this Special Use Permit will be nontransferable to the new owner.
4. No camping trailers or recreational vehicles are allowed, except one for the owner, which is allowable under the Lee County Zoning Code.
