**ORDER TO NOTIFY THE ILLINOIS STATE POLICE OF AN ADJUDICATION OF A PERSON  
AS A MENTALLY DISABLED PERSON**

This cause coming on for entry of order in compliance with 405 ILCS 5/6-103.1, 430 ILCS 65/8.1(b),  
725 ILCS 5/104-26(c)(3.5), and/or 755 ILCS 5/11a-24,

**THIS COURT FINDS:**

has a mental disability and is sentenced to imprisonment following a trial conducted pursuant to 725 ILCS 5/104-22.

**OR**

is adjudicated as a mentally disabled person as defined in 430 ILCS 65/1.1, in that, as a result of marked subnormal intelligence, or mental illness, mental impairment, incompetency, condition, or disease he or she

presents a clear and present danger to himself, herself, or to others.

lacks the mental capacity to manage his or her own affairs, or is adjudicated a disabled person as defined in 755 ILCS 5/11a-2.

is not guilty in a criminal case by reason of insanity, mental disease or defect.

is guilty but mentally ill as provided in 730 ILCS 5/2-2-6.

is incompetent to stand trial in a criminal case.

is a sexually violent person as defined in 725 ILCS 207/5(f).

is a sexually dangerous person as defined in 725 ILCS 205/1.01.

is subject to  in-patient involuntary admission under 405 ILCS 5/1-119 or  
 out-patient involuntary admission under 405 ILCS 5/1-119.1 or  
 judicial admission as set forth in 405 ILCS 5/4-500.

is subject to the provisions of the Interstate Agreements on Sexually Dangerous Persons Act under 45 ILCS 20/1 or 45 ILCS 20/2.

**WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

The Clerk of the Circuit Court is directed to immediately notify the Department of State Police, Firearm Owner's Identification Department (FOID), of the entry of this order in the form and manner required by them and shall forward a copy of this court order to the Department of State Police no later than seven (7) days after the entry of this order.
