Section 1: Instructions

- Property granted exemption pursuant to Article 15 of the Illinois Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/Article 15) must file with the Chief County Assessment Office, an annual affidavit stating whether there has been any change in ownership or use of the property. Failure to file an affidavit could result in termination of the exemption of the property.
- Property exempted under any of the following provisions are not required to submit an annual affidavit unless there is a change in ownership or use:
 - Section 15-45; Burial grounds
 - Section 15-40; Religious purposes, orphanages, or school and religious purposes
 - Section 15-50; United States property
- Return completed Affidavit on or before April 15th of each tax year to: Chief County Assessment Office, 112 E. Second Street, Dixon, IL 61021
