

GRACE PERIOD VOTING

Individuals that have not properly registered prior to the close of registration (March 7, 2023) and wish to vote in the April 4, 2023, Consolidated Election may register to vote and cast a ballot during Grace Period Voting.

Qualifications for Grace Period Voting:

Must be a US citizen

Must be 18 years of age by April 4, 2023, Consolidated Election

Must claim Lee County as their permanent residence

Must have resided within their precinct for 30 days preceding the election

Must display a current state-issued photo ID and/or two other forms of identification verifying their name and current address within Lee County

Location, Dates and Hours:

Old Lee County Courthouse, first floor, Election Department.

Wednesday, March 8, 2023, through Monday, April 4, 2023, Monday through Friday, 8:15 AM until 4:15 PM; Saturday, April 1, 2023, 9 AM until 12 noon; and Tuesday, April 4, 2023, 6 AM until 7 PM. Closed on legal holidays.

The law prohibits a person who voted during grace voting period from voting at the polls on Election Day. The votes cast during the grace voting time period will not be counted until the polls close on Election Day.
